



Annual Summary of Patriot Bible University **New Tuition Rates and Incentives for 2010**

Del Norte, Colorado - Over the last two years Patriot has been retooling and positioning for greater service; investing tens of thousands of dollars to improve and expand curriculum and programs. Patriot's investments in computers, software, and printers has enabled the school to publish, print, and deliver courses at rates less than printing companies. The investments have positioned Patriot to remain the best Christian distance learning value for decades to come. Be assured that Patriot Bible University remains debt-free.

In addition to offering top-quality courses at tremendous values, we are preparing to meet the challenge (and promise) of the coming e-Reader boom. Patriot has participated in and prepared for the international demand for higher education Bible degrees. Patriot has affiliated with 5 foreign Bible colleges serving hundreds of new students. Patriot has enabled 9 churches to operate their own Bible institute this year. We now have students in more than a dozen countries.

Over the last 12 months Patriot has released 21 courses which have been under production for the last two years. Patriot has revamped dozens more and has several more courses that will be released during the first part of 2010. Each new course is prepared by a team that invests many hours to read, research, design, beta-test, and proofread.

For The Student - For several weeks we have offered special course sales to allow students to meet their annual commitment as we reduce our overstock on certain courses.

Patriot's minimum tuition rate of \$25 was instituted when Bill Clinton was president, iPods were non-existent, and fear of the "Y2K" was just beginning. That era saw gasoline priced at \$1.22 per gallon and most people were using Windows 95 or the newly released Windows 98. This tuition rate must now come to an end.

Even with the following changes, Patriot Bible University has some of the lowest tuition fees in the country among Christian Bible colleges. Students completing only one course per month will now pay the equivalent of \$19 per credit hour for tuition (\$38 monthly tuition divided by 2 credits per course). If you complete two courses in a month, you can cut that cost in half.

New Study Incentives

Tuition Rates as of Jan 1, 2010

Plan A: Requested offering \$50-60/mo. Minimum undergraduate monthly tuition of **\$38**

Money Saving Options:

Pay Annually: \$699 for 12 courses and 12 months tuition.

Order eCourses: Only \$20. Save \$2-9 per course.

Earn a Rebate: Turn in 4 or more courses during a quarter and receive a coupon for a FREE course. Pay for 12 courses and get 16! Or you can apply it as a credit toward other fees (Yes, rebate is available to prepaid students).

Plan B: \$125 per course (includes tuition, books, and shipping)
